Direct Speech & Indirect Speech

#### Direct (Reporting) Speech

Ben said to me, "I love you the most."



#### Indirect (Reported) Speech

คือ การนำคำพูดที่ได้ยินมาเล่าให้คนอื่นฟัง

เห่น

Ben told me that he loved me.



"I love you."



## Direct Speech & Indirect Speech

- o Direct speech means to say exactly what the other one said. Quotation marks have to be used in a direct speech.
  - Kate said, "I am going swimming."
  - "The dinner will be ready in ten minutes" my mother said.



- o Indirect speech refers to a sentence expressing what the other said. Quotation marks are not used in an indirect speech.
  - Kate said she was going swimming.
  - My mother said the dinner would be ready in ten minutes.

o However, in an indirect speech, the tense should be changed; that is because when an indirect speech is used, it is always used to talk about a time in the past.

o Sometimes an indirect speech will use a reporting verb such as tell, ask and say.

Direct Speech John said, "I did this exercise last night."

#### Reported Speech

Look at the girl on the right. We would turn the statement into the reported speech by changing:

- → the verb from the <u>present simple</u> to the <u>past simple</u>
- → the personal pronoun <u>I</u> to <u>she</u>
- → the possessive pronoun my to her The sentence would then be:

The girl said she loved her new dress.





The girl said <u>her</u> mother <u>gave</u> <u>her</u> new dolls regularly.







The woman said <u>her</u> book <u>was</u> <u>being</u> very interesting.

#### Reported Speech

The man said <u>he had been</u> so tired <u>he</u> passed out on the middle of the street.





The woman said it <u>had been</u> years since <u>she</u> had had that much fun.

It has been years since I ve had this much fun!




The girl said she would catch a fish that day.



## Direct Speech & Indirect Speech

- ODirect Speech means to say exactly what the other one said. Quotation marks have to be used in a direct speech.
  - Kate said, "I am going swimming."
  - The dinner will be ready in ten minutes my mother said.

## Direct Speech & Indirect Speech

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- o However, in an inclinect speech, the tense should be changed; that is because when an indirect speech is used, it is always used to talk about a time in the past.
- o Sometimes an inclinect speech will use a reporting verb such as tell, ask and say.



Look at the girl on the right. We would turn the statement into the reported speech by changing:

- the verb from the present simple to the past simple
- $\rightarrow$  the personal pronoun  $\underline{I}$  to  $\underline{she}$
- the possessive pronoun my to her

The sentence would then be:

The girl said she loved her new dress.

The girl said her mother gave her new dolls regularly.
